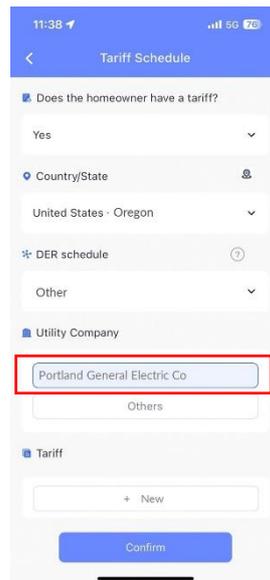


Smart Battery pilot Enrollment Guidance

Franklin Home Power customers may enroll in the PGE Smart Battery pilot via the FranklinWH App.

Prerequisites

The installer or homeowner selects **Portland General Electric Co** as the Utility Company on the Tariff Schedule page.



The **Virtual Power Plant** option (Step 1, next page) will appear in the menu bar on the home page.

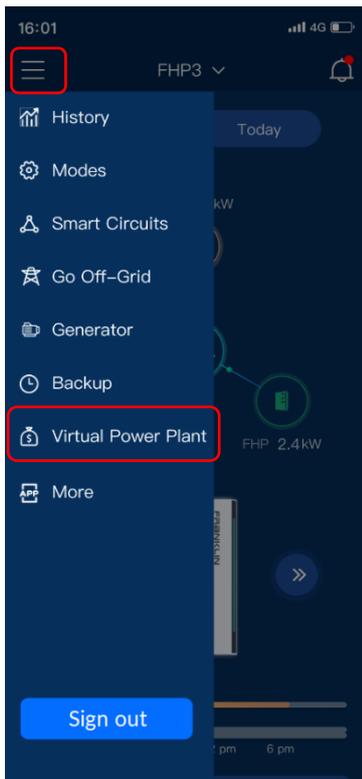
***Note:** Once you return to the homepage, you need to manually scroll down the screen to refresh, then you will be able to access the **Virtual Power Plant** option in the menu.

Procedure

The device registration steps are described below.

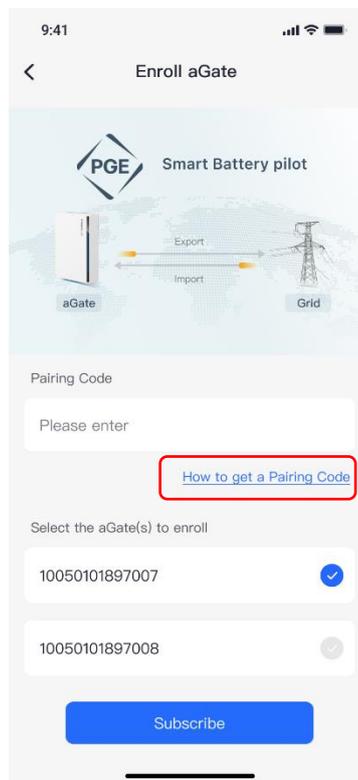
1. Log into the FranklinWH App on the homeowner account. Tap the menu in the upper left corner.

Tap **Virtual Power Plant** to begin enrollment.

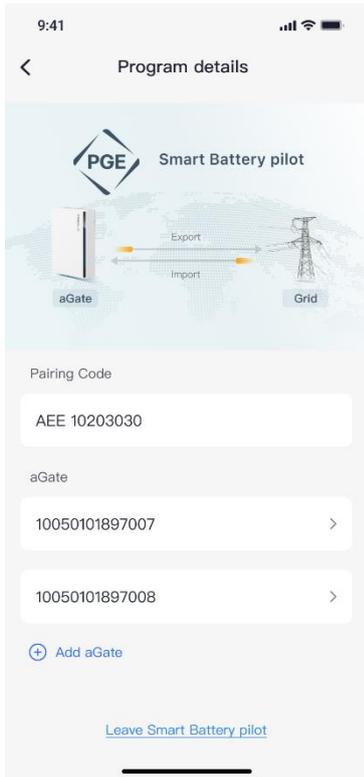


2. Tap **How to get a Pairing Code** to go to the Smart Battery pilot registration page. After completing the event registration and passing the review, you will receive a Pairing Code.

You may then enter the Pairing Code and select the aGate to enroll.



3. The Pairing Code will be shown on the page when the aGate has been successfully enrolled. You may add the aGate or remove the enrolled aGate from the list.



4. Prior to a grid event (import, export or standby), you will receive a push notification informing you of event times and power.

Example:

“Join the export period from [Date][Time] to [Time], power xx kW.

Tap on a registered aGate in the **Program details** page (shown in the previous step) to enter **Demand Response Events** page. Select the specific event to check the event details.

***NOTE:** Participation in the event is enabled by default.
